We had a chance for an exclusive interview with the individual who has been walking around Guelph with signs. The transcript is below:

Question: Thank you for meeting with me. Can we start with your name? Who are you?

A: People have places to get to, I don't want to add to their stress by creating traffic. I am in no rush. I anticipate these statements to stay true for the foreseeable future.

Q: I really can't think of anything more to say or ask you about.

A: Thank you, that is a great compliment.
