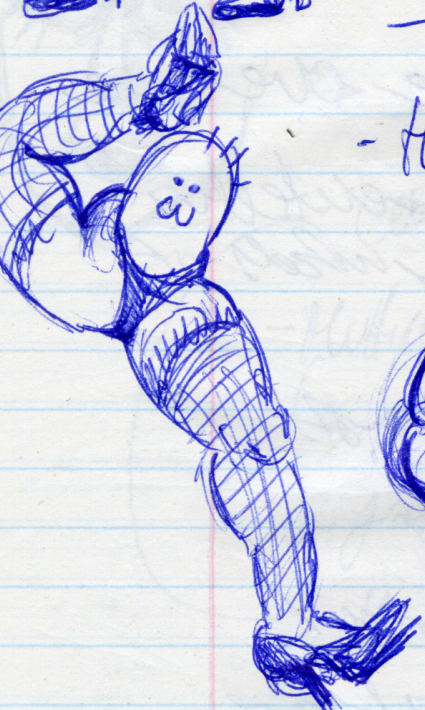

- establishment of Mycenaean palace centers (on mainland + 2nd strand)
- Sites: Mycenae, Tiryns, ~~Aegina~~, Pylos
- Minoan-inspired

- College of museums pathology museums, sex museum, historical houses

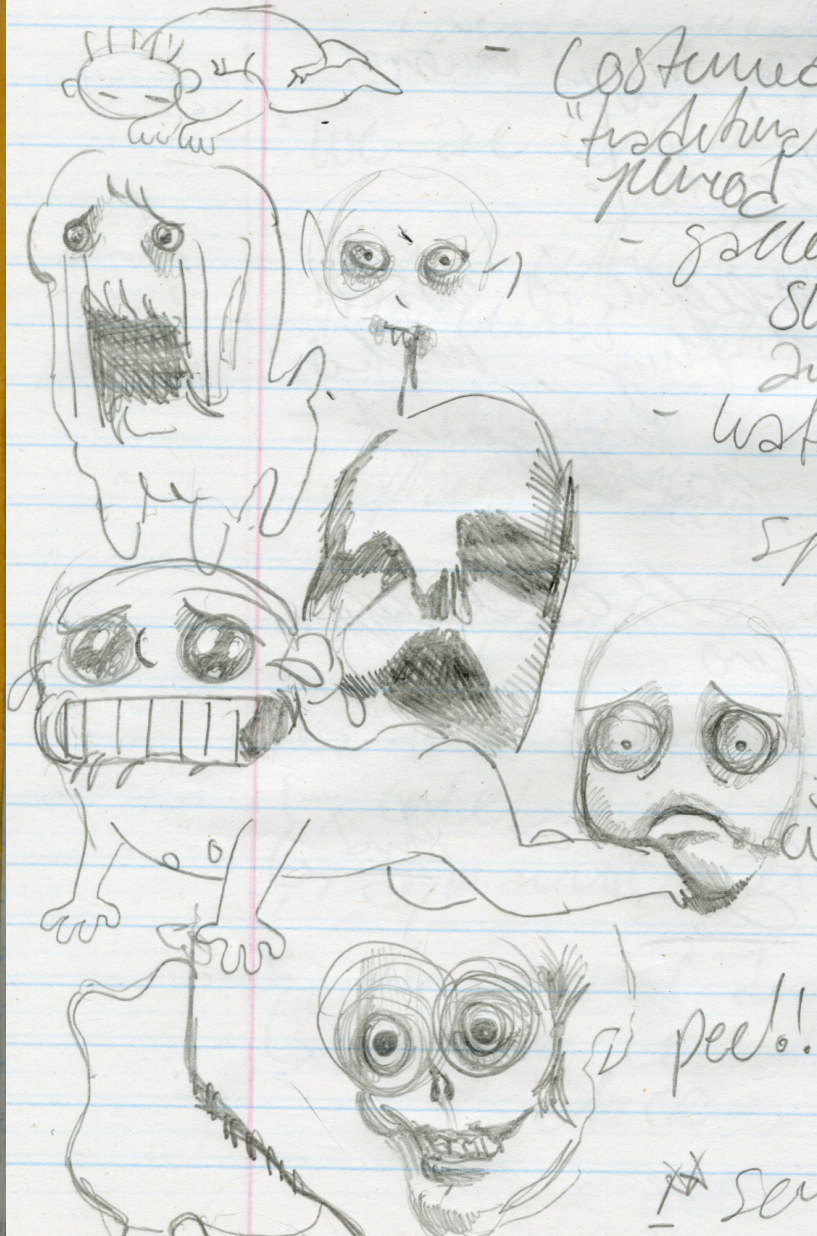
Joseph Schuncke Haus

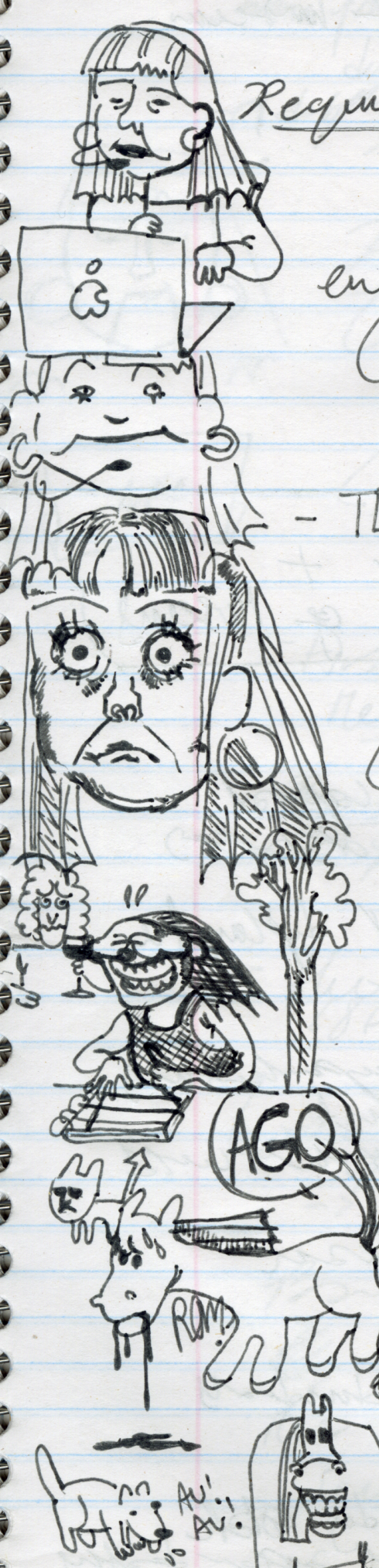
- TLDR; Museums present internal culture by way of supporting the importance of these findings w/ research
